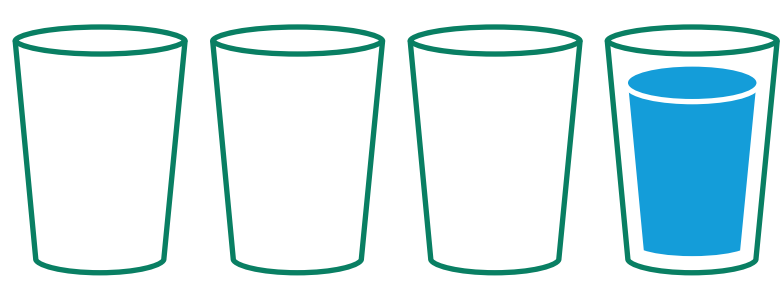


A world with limits

The world is full of limits, from overdrafts and phone contracts to how long you can survive without food or water.

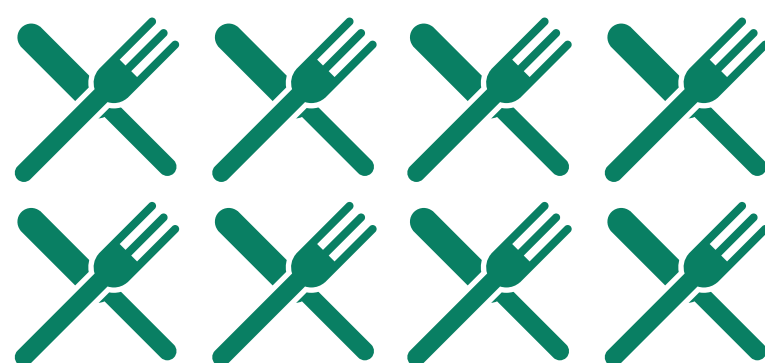

If Earth were flat, you could see bright lights hundreds of miles away. The farthest object visible to the naked eye is the Andromeda galaxy, 2.6 million light-years away.
